LADIES LUNCH GROUP



STEWARDSHIP AS A LIFESTYLE



I picked up a paperback book written by George Beverly Shea in a thrift store recently. Some of you may remember the Billy Graham Crusades that were televised for almost 60 years and brought the message to millions of people all over the world. George Beverly Shea joined Billy Graham's team in 1947 as the "gospel singer" and was well known for his rendition of "How Great Thou Art." He would sing a solo immediately preceding Billy Graham's message at each crusade meeting.

His book, "How Sweet the Sound," shares memories and stories of his time with Billy Graham while recounting some of the history of the old hymns and gospel songs. I have enjoyed reading this book and learning more about the old hymns through the words of George Beverly Shea. He passed away at the age of 104 in Asheville, NC in 2013. Mr. Shea and Mr. Graham both had homes in Montreat, NC, where I attend the Worship and Music Conference every summer. Mr. Shea's music touched many lives over the years of his service.
