# Glad tidings from the Pastor's Pen

Dear friends.

Lent continues for three more weeks as we move into March 2024. The last two Sundays will be Palm Sunday followed by Holy Week and Easter Sunday. Just to let you know, many pastors take a two-week vacation to recover from the helter-skelter of trying to make sure everything is perfect. So far, I haven't taken but a few days as Eastertide concludes.

This month's sermons will be from the Gospel of John, except for Easter Sunday when the sermon will be from Luke. But before Easter Sunday, we will have waved our palm branches with loud Hosannas sung at the beginning of the service, which, as it moves through, we contemplate the passion of Christ as the service concludes and follows into the remainder of Holy Week.

During Holy Week the ministers of our community will be inviting our community to come to services and a meal on the days of this week. Watch for the dates, locations, and times of the services. I will be preaching at The Oaks Baptist Church on Tuesday evening of Holy Week at 6 PM. There will be another service at lunchtime on Wednesday at the Cornerstone Church. The full schedule will be posted for these days and others as they are firmed up.

As is our custom, on Saturday evening and Easter Sunday morning we will celebrate again as we place flowers upon the cross as it has been done for many years. It is a beautiful symbol reminding us that Christ is risen. We will continue the celebration entering the sanctuary with Song and Praise and Celebration. The Lord is risen. Christ is Risen, indeed! Alleluia! Amen.

# Shouldn't You Be a Greeter?


Would you like to see more of your fellow congregants? Does making visitors feel welcome give you a warm sense of purpose? If so, we have a great opportunity for you!

# Finance Update for March 2024

The session approved a 2024 budget that forecasts 4.4% higher income than 2023. Actual 2023 pledged and unplugged income was higher than budgeted for both categories. The new budget includes roughly the same amount of transfers from our savings as budgeted for 2023; actual transfers in 2023 were lower than planned.
