### Glad tidings from the Pastor's Pen

Alleluia Christ is Risen Indeed! Yesterday we ended March with a celebration of the Resurrection and its empty tomb. Our Gospels differ in what happens to the disciples after the three days.

In Mark, the original scripture says the women were told by an angel to go tell the disciples, but the women were trembling and bewildered. They fled from the tomb and said nothing because they were afraid.

In Matthew's gospel, he props up what Mark wrote, saying the angel told the women, he is risen from the dead, go tell the disciples. So, the women left still afraid, but with joy as they ran to tell his disciples. So, they found Jesus in Galilee, and he gave them his marching orders, The Great Commission.

Luke's gospel is full of the stories of Jesus. After the resurrection, Jesus walks with two followers but they don't recognize him until he breaks bread with them and they saw him. Later he shows up walking through the locked door where the disciples were hiding out. He says be at peace, I am not a ghost, have you anything to eat, I'm hungry. Then he opened their minds to scripture and told them to wait for the Holy Spirit to come. Jesus later Ascends into the heavens.

In John's gospel, Jesus incognito appears to Mary Magdeline, in the upper room, and on the beach. He shows the fishermen, Andrew, Peter, James and John where to catch fish. Jesus cooks some of the fish for breakfast and then has an important talk with Peter forgiving him and instructing him about what his discipleship will be like.

My friends, where might the resurrected Jesus find us in our daily tasks in 2024? Do we have the vision to see him as he really is? What might he tell us about what our discipleship will be like? An important key is to seek God's presence within ourselves and LISTEN!



# Speaking Glory and Honor

As we continue to celebrate the Easter season throughout April, let us remember to praise God for the gift of Jesus and the forgiveness of our sins. One way our church gives praise is by singing the Doxology every Sunday. The word "Doxology" comes from the Greek words "doxa" meaning "honor" or "glory" and "logia" meaning "to speak."

How many of you knew that our Doxology also has verses? Fourteen verses to be exact! Bishop Thomas Ken wrote the hymn "Awake, My Soul, and with the Sun" for his students at Winchester College in England. Bishop Ken believed that singing a hymn first thing in the morning was an integral part of spiritual health

and well-being. His students may not have always appreciated singing all fourteen verses at one time, but the final verse of his hymn has endured for over 300 years. PRAISE GOD!
